Maston who under date of October 5th 1853 entered the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 5, Township 75 North, Range 28, Madison County, Iowa, from the United States Government; that I was also well and personally acquainted with William H. Maston who under date of December 29th 1863 secured a patent from the State of Iowa to the above described land, said patent being recorded in Book 17 page 300 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that I was also well and personally acquainted with William H. Mastin who under date of January 31st 1882 deeded the above described land to me, said deed being recorded in Book 19 page 633 of said records, and I know that the said W.H. Maston, William H. Maston, and William H. Mastin above mentioned refers to one identical and the same person.
