I, George Hornback a resident of the city of Winterset, Iowa, being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with R.P. Bruce who entered and to whom was Patented the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No. Three (3) Township No. Seventy-five (75) North of Range No. Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. of Iowa, and of my own personal knowledge know that the said R.P. Bruce who entered said land and the Richard P. Bruce who conveyed the said land to Samuel Duncan on June 16th 1853, is one and the same person. That the W.J. McConnelley to whom Jacob Hircock and wife on April 12th 1890 conveyed a strip of land off the East side of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No. 4 Township No. 75 North of Range No. 28 West of the 5th P.M. of Iowa, and the William J. McConnelley who together with his wife Hattie C. conveyed the same to Nancy J. Daniels on March 4th 1893, is one and the same person. That I am in no way interested in making the above statements.
