I, J.R. McKee, being first duly sworn, depose and say:-  
That I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa, that I was well and personally acquainted with the parties named in this affidavit, and that I have no interest in making the same except to establish the truth of the facts stated herein. That the Jesse Pafford who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed executed by George W. Hogg and Dicy E. Hogg, his wife, on the 12th day of April, 1873, and recorded April 26<sup>th</sup> 1873 in Deed Record 7 page 414 of Madison County, Iowa, is the same and identical person as the Jesse Pafford who is named as grantor in a certain quit claim deed to Elizabeth Ann Pafford, dated May 22nd, 1874 and recorded June 3rd, 1874 in Deed Record 10 page 142 of Madison County, Iowa, his correct name being Jesse Pafford, and the said Elizabeth Ann Pafford being the wife of the said Jesse Pafford at the time he executed said quit claim deed to her. That the Elizabeth Ann Pafford named as grantee in the said quit claim deed above described was the same and identical person as the Elizabeth A. Pafford who executed a certain warranty deed to James Cummings on the 6th day of May, 1875, which was recorded June 12th, 1875 in Deed Record 11 page 215 of Madison County, Iowa, and that the said Elizabeth A. Pafford was unmarried when she executed said deed to James Cummings. That the Daniel Leech who is named as grantee in a certain deed executed by W.D. McLaughlin and wife on the 18th day of September, 1882 and recorded in Deed Record 20 page 381 of Madison County, Iowa on the 6th day of October, 1882, is the same and identical persons as the Daniel Leach who with his wife executed to myself a certain warranty deed on the 30th day of July, 1884, and which was recorded in Deed Record 23 page 562 of Madison County, Iowa, on the 31st day of July, 1884. That the R.B. Rainey who is named as grantee in a certain warranty deed executed by E.A. McClelland on January 3rd, 1895 and recorded on the 11th day of January, A.D. 1895 in Deed Record 35 page 108 of Madison County, Iowa, is the same and identical person as the R.B. Rainey who with his wife executed a certain warranty deed to E.E. McCall on the 30th day of October, 1896 and which deed was recorded November 20<sup>th</sup> 1896 in Deed Record 37 page 128 of Madison County, Iowa, his correct name being R.B. Rainey. That the M.J. Burdick who is named as grantee in a certain deed executed by Juna Hogg, widow, on the 24th day of July, 1903 and recorded August 24<sup>th</sup> 1903 in Deed Record 45 page 421 of Madison County, Iowa, and who is also named as grantor in a certain deed by her executed to William Hogg, on the 28th day of July, 1903 and recorded August 24th, 1903 in Deed Record 45 page 422 of Madison County, Iowa, is the same and identical person as the Margaret J. Burdick who is named as an heir of William Hogg, deceased, and Elizabeth Hogg, deceased, in the respective registry of heirs filed in their estates in Madison County, Iowa, and who is also named as one of the grantors in a certain quit claim deed to Leroy F. Clifton, dated July 30<sup>th</sup>, 1910 and recorded in Deed Record 34 page 530 of Madison County, Iowa, her full name being Margaret J. Burdick.
