I, Harry W. Hill, being first duly affirmed, depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with my Uncle, J.W. Hill Grantee in Deed dated February 28, 1880 conveying the West Half (W₁) of Lot Four (4) Block Eleven (11) together with other lots in the town of Earlham, Iowa, recorded in Madison County records, in book two, page 419; also J.W. Hill, Grantee of a deed dated September 14, 1881, conveying the East Half (E₁) of Lot Four (4) Block Eleven (11) with other lots in the town of Earlham, Iowa, recorded in Book 5 page 76, Madison County records. And that Jesse W. Hill Grantee in Deed dated July 29, 1875 conveying the West Half (W₁) of Lots 5,6,7, Block Eleven (11) Town of Earlham, Iowa, recorded in book One (1) page 285 Madison County records is one and the same party as J.W. Hill Grantee in the two above mentioned deeds. And that J.W. Hill and Jesse W. Hill are one and the same party as Jesse W. Hill, Grantor, in Deed dated December 21, 1891 conveying lot four (4) and the West Half (W₁) of Lots 5,6,7, all in Block Eleven (11) original town of Earlham, Iowa, recorded in book 7, page 637 Madison County records. I further state that I am well and personally acquainted with Almedia R. Wroe legatee under certain Will of Richard M. Wroe, deceased, per Probate records, Madison County, Iowa, #1143. And that the said Almedia R. Wroe and Almedea R. Wroe registered as heir under said will, is one and the same party. I further state that the said Almedia R. Wroe has been in full and peaceable possession of Lot Four (4) and the west half (W₁) of lots 5,6,7, Block Eleven (11) original town of Earlham, Iowa, ever since the said Will of her husband Richard M. Wroe, deceased, was probated in Madison County, Iowa. Signed this 21st day of Feb. 1911.
