State of Iowa, Madison County, SS:

I, Porter Rollstin, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, since the year 1857, and that I am now 78 years of age. That I was well and personally acquainted with Owen K. Vanscoyoc the grantee in a deed from Asa Poleson and his wife Alvira, dated January 14th, 1868, conveying the Southeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Three (3) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty Seven (27) West of the 5th P.M. as shown by deed record No. 1, page 109 of the records of said County, and that from my personal knowledge and acquaintance with the man, I am well satisfied and convinced that he is the same and identical person as Owen K. Vanscoyoc, who conveyed said land on July 2nd, 1872, to Rosa Ann Vanscoyoc, as shown by deed record No. 7, page 90 of the records of said county, and that he is the same and identical person as O.K. Vanscoyoc, grantee in a deed from this affiant and wife, dated January 23rd, 1875, as shown by deed record No. 11, page 34 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying the South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, Township and Range, and that he is also the same and identical person as the O.K. Vanscoyoc, who is grantee in a deed from Casper Ambrest and wife, dated March 1st, 1875, as shown by deed record No. 11, page 353, conveying the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, Township and range, and also the same and identical person as O.K. Vanscoy, the plaintiff in the proceedings in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, to quiet title, in which David Wilkinson et al were defendants, had on February 25th, 1878, as shown by the decree in said cause recorded on page 326 of District Court Record 2 of the records of said county; in other words, wherever in the title to the East Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Township and Range the name of Owen K. Vanscoyoc, Owen K. Vanscoyoc, O.K. Vanscoyoc, O.K. Vanscoye, Owen K. Vanscoy, or O.K. Vanscoyoc appears it, in each and every instance, in my belief, refers to one and the same person. Further affiant saith not.
