I, C.H. Young of St Charles, Iowa, first being duly sworn, upon oath do depose and say that on or about March 1st 1870 a conveyance of the Und  $\frac{1}{2}$  SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 14-74-26 was made to C.H. Young, recorded in Deed Record 2 page 352 of Madison Co. Iowa, and on April 15 1884 the above described land was conveyed by a Q.C.D. to Chas. H. Young, (see Deed Record 21, page 236) and April 1st 1881 C.H. Young conveyed to Charles W. Young, and recorded in Deed Record 19, page 176. The C.H. Young and Chas. H. Young, above mentioned are one and the same identical person. That I was well and personally acquainted with Susan Irwin who was the grantee to the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 14-74-26, dated Sept. 13, 1859, recorded in Deed Record 0 page 123 of Madison Co. Iowa; That she later intermarried with William Stone who died prior to the conveyance of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 14-74-26 on April 4, 1878 by Susan Stone, Deed Record 16, page 315. and that she was a widow at the time of said conveyance April 4, 1878. That I have learned the facts as to dates of conveyances, book and page from abstract #7069 made by C.M. Condit. Further the deponent sayeth not.
