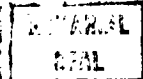

State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, David Cline, of said County and State, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of David Cline to whom J.J. Hutchings on or about October 26th, 1854, conveyed the South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty One (21) in Township Seventy Six (76) North, of Range Twenty eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, and that said J.J. Hutchings, the grantor, was the same and identical man as the Joseph J. Hutchings to whom said land was patented. That Perry Cline, to whom myself and my brother John L. Cline, with our wives, on or about December 30th, 1879, conveyed the two elevenths interest in and to the west half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the South Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township, and range, was the same and identical man as the C.P. Cline, who was granted in certain conveyances for the same real estate, or interests therein, one being from E.M. Paullin and husband dated on or about November 10th, 1879, one from Mary Ellen Paullin and husband dated on or about September 11th, 1880, one being from Esther Ellen Carroll and husband dated on or about August 21st, 1880, and one being from Malinda Church and husband dated on or about January 14th, 1880; and that he was the same and identical man as the Commodore P. Cline who with his wife on or about the 20th day of December, 1882, conveyed to me the south west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the north east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the east fifteen (15) acres of the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, township, and range; in other words Perry Cline, C.P. Cline, and Commodore P. Cline, wherever such names appear in the chain of title to said real estate refer to one and the same person; that the Esther Ellen Carroll referred to above as grantor in a conveyance to said C.P. Cline was the same person as the Esther Ellen Cline, named in the registry of heirs of my father David Cline as a minor heir of George Cline, my brother; that the E.M. Paullin referred to above as grantor in a conveyance to C.P. Cline was the same and identical person as Esther M. Paullin named in the registry of heirs of my father David Cline; that Malinda Church named as grantor in one of the conveyances above referred to, to C.P. Cline, was the same person as Malinda J. Church named in the registry of heirs of my father David Cline; that Melinda Cline who on or about September 9th, 1882, conveyed to Commodore P. Cline the five elevenths ($\frac{5}{11}$) of the west half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the north East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and the south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the Section, Township and range aforesaid; was the same person as the Malinda Cline named as the widow of said David Cline, and that she was also the same person as the Melinda Cline who on or about the same date conveyed to John L. Cline the one eleventh ($\frac{1}{11}$) of said real estate. That the writing of the name John T. Cline in the conveyance executed by John L. Cline and myself to Perry Cline on or about December 30th, 1879, conveying the two elevenths ($\frac{2}{11}$) of the real estate last above described, was a clerical error, said conveyance having been in fact to my own knowledge executed by my brother John L. Cline, grantee with me in conveyances of said real estate from our brothers William R. Cline and Samuel Cline before made, and that the writing the initial "T" in place of "L" was a clerical error.
