Territory of Oklahoma Oklahoma County SS:

I, A.W.C. Weeks, on oath say, that I was formerly a resident of Madison County, Iowa and during the years commencing about 1870, and for about thirty years thereafter I was engaged in the real estate and the loan business to a greater or less extent in said County; that as such loan agent I negotiated a loan on the west fractional half of the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nineteen (19), in Township Seventy Four (74) North of Range Twenty Seven (27) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, for S.W. and M.T. Hiatt to L.F. Billings, dated on or about October 1st, 1875, for the sum of Five Hundred and no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars; that at that time I made an investigation to ascertain wheather or not Hiram Echols, who on or about August 23rd, 1870 conveyed said real estate unto James Hiatt, as shown by the conveyance recorded in deed record "6" of Madison County, Iowa, at page 92 thereof, was at the time of the execution of said deed an unmarried man, and that I learned at that time to my own satisfaction that the said Hiram Echols was at the time of the execution of said deed a single and unmarried man, and that while at this time I have no distinct and independent recollection of the matter, yet I believe such to be the fact, as is shown by a letter which I wrote to the Iowa Loan & Trust Company regarding said matter on or about October 7th, 1875, which letter is attached to this affidavit as Exhibit A and made a part hereof.
