Wilkinson, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with the persons named below and make the following statements from personal knowledge; That the Joseph J. Hutchings who was the patentee of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 36-75-29 was the same and identical person as the J.J. Hutchings who died about April 27th, 1888 and whose will was admitted to probate in Madison County, Iowa, May 14th, 1888 as shown by Probate Minute Book 2, page 184. That the James Callanan Jr. who obtained title to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 36-75-29 by deed recorded in Deed Record "U", page 301, was the same and identical person as the James Callanan who afterward executed a conveyance for said real estate dated March 26th, 1890 and recorded in Deed Record 22, page 468. That Ronald Bain was an unmarried man on June 29th, 1871 when he conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 31-75-28 by deed recorded in Deed Record 6, page 46. All of above named records being of the records of Madison County, Iowa. Further deponent sayeth not.
