Parker bequeathed lands in Madison County, Iowa, a certified transcript of said will being filed in the records of Madison County, Iowa, October 2nd, 1882, as shown by Probate Index "C", page 29, was the same and identical person as the Ellen B. Parker whose will was admitted to Probate in Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania, May 3rd, 1886 and as the Mrs E.B. Parker to whom John A. Macumber and wife conveyed certain lands in Sec. 31-75-28 by quit claim deed dated March 14th, 1885, and recorded in Deed Record 21, page 409 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, the said Ellen B. Parker being my mother's aunt. I further depose and say that I am the only heir at law of the Fanny W. Farr, named in the said will of Ellen B. Parker and am also the William W. Farr who executed a quit claim deed to M.E. Harris for the fractional west half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the North West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), Section 31-75-28, dated April 26" 1911 and recorded in Deed Record 39 page 520, of the records of Madison County, Iowa. Further deponent sayeth not.
