I, Mary E. Rogers, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with John Hogg, who entered the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 1-74-29, under certificate #5568 and to whom same land was patented by the United States Government June 3rd, 1856 and that he was the same and identical person as the John Hogg who entered the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 36-75-29 under certificate #210 and to whom same land was patented by the United States Government May 1st, 1855 and was also the same person as the John Hogg who with his wife, Jane, conveyed both of above described tracts of land together with other land to William I. Harris by deed dated April 25th, 1865 and recorded in Record "Q", page 145 of the records of Madison County, Iowa. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the William I. Harris mentioned above and that he was the same and identical person as the W.I. Harris, to whom Edmund B. Thomson and wife conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 31-75-28, by deed dated January 11th, 1875 and recorded in Deed Record 10, page 459; that he was also the same and identical person as the W.I. Harris to whom H.H. Kilgore and wife conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 35-75-29 and other land, by deed dated March 26th, 1890 and recorded in Deed Record 30, page 3; and was also the same and identical person as the William I. Harris to whom Edison P. Smith and wife conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 1-74-29, by deed dated April 20th, 1870 and recorded in Deed Record "Q", page 388; and that he was the same and identical person as the W.I. Harris Sr. who conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 31-75-28, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 35-75-29 and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 1-74-29 to M.E. Harris, by deed dated February 9th, 1893 and recorded in Deed Record 32, page 614. I further depose and say that I am a daughter of E.B. Thomson, who with his wife executed a mortgage for \$575.00 to Frederick Hompstead upon the W Fr. $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 31-75-28, said mortgage being dated March 1st, 1870 and recorded in Mortgage Record 2, page 69, and that he was the same and identical person as the Edmund B. Thompson, to whom F.W. Homsted executed a release for above described mortgage, dated February 14th, 1871 and recorded in Miscellaneous Record 1, page 128 and that the said F.W. Homsted who executed said release was the same and identical person as the said Frederick Hompstead to whom above described mortgage was executed. All of the above named records being of the records of Madison County, Iowa.
