State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, B.C. Guiliams, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of South Township, Madison County, Iowa since the year 1852; that during the whole of said time I have lived within a short distance of Section 7 in said Township and have been personally acquainted with all of the owners of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SP $\frac{1}{2}$ 7-75-26; that I was well and personally acquainted with Thomas Runkle and M.C. Debord on May 11th, 1861 when they conveyed a certain tract of land out of said 40 acre tract to John Henkle, Elisha Miller and Henry Gratner, Trustees, for cemetery purposes, and I well and personally know the tract of land intended to be conveyed by the said Thomas Runkle and M.C. Debord and I know the description of the tract of land taken possession of under said deed; that the tract of land intended to be conveyed by said deed and the tract of land taken possession of under said deed is described as follows:- Commencing at a point 21 rods East of the North West Corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SP $\frac{1}{2}$ 7-75-26, running thence South 71 links, thence East 300 links, thence North 71 links, thence West 300 links to the place of beginning; that no other part of said 40 acre tract has ever been used for cemetery purposes nor has any other part of said 40 acre tract ever been claimed under said deed from Thomas Runkle and M.C. Debord.
