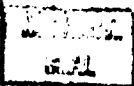
State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

The undersigned Derrick Bennett, being first duly sworn upon oath deposes and says, that I was well and personally acquainted with the facts as set out below. To-wit:- That the John Allen Pitzer who acquired title to the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 36-76-28, by entry on Peby, 4th, 1850, and the John A. Pitzer, who conveyed Lot 3 in Block 9 Pitzers & Knights Add to Winterset, Iowa, on Feb. 5, 1855, said deed being recorded in Deed Record "A" on Page 534, and that John Allen Pitzer and John A. Pitzer was one and the same person. That Jno. B. Vawter the grantee in a deed made July, 1, 1856 made by Abraham Leach and recorded in Record "E" on Page "152" and J.G. Vawter who was one of the grantors in a deed made Oct, 28, 1856 and recorded in Record "E" page 242 conveying Lot 3 in Block "9" in P. & K Add to Winterset Iowa, was one and the same person, and that wherever the name Jno. G. Vawter, J.G. Vawter or Jno. B. Vawter appears on the records herein named it is the same person, and that his correct name was Jno. G. Vawter. That I was well and personally acquainted with William C. Harper who conveyed Lot 4 in Block 9 in Pitzers and Knights add to Winterset, Iowa, on July 14, 1855, as shown recorded in Record "D" on page 209 and that the said William C. Harper was a single and unmarried man on the date he made said conveyance to-wit: July, 14, 1855. Further deponent sayeth not.
