State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, Abe Smith, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:- That Aquilla Smith, named as grantor in a deed to E.A. Huber, dated April 24th, 1862, recorded in Deed Record "K" at page 320 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying all that tract of land lying South of the State Road leading West from Winterset to Council Bluffs in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 36-76-28 was my grand father; that his wife's name was Elizabeth Smith and that she died prior to the death of my said grand-father Aquilla Smith; that he was only married one time and that said Elizabeth was the only wife he ever married; that the Maranda Smith named as grantor in the deed to E.A. Huber, for the same property, dated April 24th, 1862 and recorded in Deed Record "K" at page 321 of said Madison County, Iowa Records was a daughter of said Aquilla Smith and lived with him and kept house for him after the death of my said grand-mother, Elizabeth Smith. That my said grand-father nor said Maranda Smith never lived upon the property described in said deeds but resided and had their home on the South East Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the South West Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Thirty-six (36) Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M. That said Maranda Smith at the time of the execution of said last described deed was unmarried. Further depenent sayeth not.
