I, J.D. Hubbard being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously since the year 1861; that I was well and personally acquainted with Benjamin Hircock, he being my 1861; that I was well and personally acquainted with Benjamin Hircock, he being my prother-in-law, and the same person named as grantee in a certain Warranty Deed made and executed by S.V. White and wife under date of October 4th, 1866, and recorded in Book "T" page 118 of the records of said County and State, which deed conveys Lot 2 in Sec. 31-77-26 and two acres in Sec. 34-77-27, and I know that he is the same identical person who as B.F. Hermon together with his wife, Mary A. deeded a part of the above described real estate to W.B. Folwell, said deed being dated October 30th, 1895 and recorded in Book 29 page 140 of said records. That the said Benjamin Hircock is now deceased, and at the date of his death was a resident of Kansas, that he has two brothers in this county who have legally changed their name from Hircock to Hermon, and the said Benjamin Hircock upon moving out of this state to Kansas simply adopted the name said Benjamin Hircock upon moving out of this state to Kansas simply adopted the name of Hermon in order to keep the family name straight.
