I, A.N. Canfield of lawful age, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say, that for more than 40 years last past I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa; That I was well and personally acquainted with Alexander Thornbrue, who was grantee in a certain deed dated June 1st 1869 conveying the SE 1/4 11-74-26, and recorded in Deed Record W page 638 of the records of said County; and that he was the same and identical person as the John A. Thornbrue who with his wife (Matilda) conveyed the above described real estate to M.D. Canfield by Warranty Deed dated January 5th. 1872 and recorded in Deed Record 7 page 854 of the records of said County; his name being John Alexander Thornbrue and he being known by the name of and his right name being John A. Thornbrue. That I was well and personally acquainted with the M.D. Canfield named as grantee in the last mentioned deed and know that he was the same and identical person as the Moses D. Canfield who with his wife (Margaret) conveyed the above described real estate to Richard Worthing by Warranty Deed dated March 31st. 1880 and recorded in Deed Record 18 page 401 of the records of said County, that his true name was Moses D. Canfield. The above statements are made from my own personal knowledge and are true as I verily believe.
