

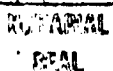

I, F.D. Campbell, a resident of said County and State, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with D.P. Cooper and wives, dated October 19th, 1875, conveying Lot 5 and 20 feet off of the West side of Lot 6 in Block 7 of Railroad Addition to Winterset, Iowa, and know that he is the same and identical person as David P. Barker, grantee in a deed from C.M. Woody and wife, dated November 2nd, 1876, conveying the undivided one-half of the above described property, and that he is also the same as D.P. Barker, who with his wife, M.A., conveyed all of said property to Richard French, by deed dated June 25th, 1877. That I was also well and personally acquainted with the said Richard French and know that he is the same and identical person as R. French, who with his wife Rosie H., conveyed said real estate to S.G. Ruby by deed dated January 4th, 1883. Further affiant saith not.
