Kindle, grantee in a deed from the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad Company, dated May 25th, 1874, conveying the Northwest Quarter (¼) of the Southwest Quarter (¼) of Section Six (6) in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) and know that he is the same and identical person as J.H. Kindle, who with his wife, Mary E., conveyed said land to J.M. Kindle, by deed dated August 22nd, 1878; that I was well and personally acquainted with the said J.M. Kendall, grantor in a quit claim deed to said John F. Wasson, dated February 20th, 1912, conveying the aforesaid real estate. Further affiant saith not.
