I, William Croft being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I am a nephew of Charles Foglesong who at one time was the owner in fee simple of the following described real estate situated in Madison County, Iowa, to-wit: Five acres off the North end of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 26-77-28; that he obtained title to said land by warranty deed executed by Levi Foglesong and wife, (Ann) dated, October 16th, 1869 and recorded in Book 3 page 133 of the records of said County; that I was also well and personally acquainted with Charles Fogelsong named as one of the defendants in a certain action in equity in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, wherein Charles L.
