I, Anderson Barnett being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I have been a resident of said County and State for the past 55 years; that I was well and personally acquainted with Michael E. White, Sr. who at once time was the owner in fee simple of the following described real estate, situated in Madison County, State of Iowa to-wit: The West Half of the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter, of Secof Iowa to-wit: The West Half of the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter, of Section 26, Township 77 North, Range 28, West of the 5th P.M. Iowa, (except however 5 acres off the north end thereof); that the said Michael E. White, Sr. departed this life intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 18th day of July A.D. 1881, and that at the date of his death the said Michael E. White, Sr. left a widow namely, Mary A. White, whose full and true name was Mary Ann White, and the following named children, as his sole and only heirs at law, to-wit: John W. White, Minerva Nocholson formerly Minerva White, Rache el Logan formerly Rachel White, Samuel F. White who is the same and identical person as S.F.
