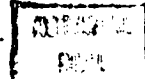
State of Iowa, Madison County SS:

I, W.S. Whedon being duly sworn on oath state that I was a resident of Madison County, State of Iowa. That I was well acquainted with Isaac G. Houk who at one time owned the $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 32-76-27 and who conveyed said land on October 29th, 1870 to C.D. Bevington. That the said land was conveyed to said Isaac G. Houk on May 17th, 1866, but in the said conveyance, which was executed by J.F. Brock, Sheriff of Madison County, Iowa, the name of the grantee was written "I.G. Houk". And I know of my own personal knowledge that the said Isaac G. Houk and I.G. Houk were one and the same person; for there never was but one person of that name who ever owned said land.
