I, S.S. Guiberson being duly sworn on oath state that I was a resident of Madison County, State of Iowa. That I was well acquainted with Meshack Casteel who at one time owned the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 32-76-27 and who conveyed the said land by warranty deed on March 9th, 1854 to John Short. That the said land was conveyed to the said Meshack Casteel on December 9th, 1852 by Martin Wheeler and wife, but in the said conveyance the name of the said grantee was erroneously spelled "Mesheck Casteel". And I know of my own personal knowledge that the said Meshack Casteel and Mesheck Casteel were one and the same person; for there never was but one person of that name who ever owned said land, and that the said Meshack Casteel was an unmarried man on March 9th, 1854.
