I, Frank L. Drake, being duly sworn, depose and say:-  
 That I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa and that I am, by profession, an abstractor of titles and am familiar with record titles to property in the City of Winterset, Iowa, and am especially well acquainted with the record title of Lot Five (5) in Block Seventeen (17) in the Original Town of Winterset, Iowa; and that the middle One Third ( $\frac{1}{3}$ ) of Lot Five (5) in Block Seventeen (17) runs East and West through said Block Seventeen (17), and faces on Front Street, and that said middle One Third ( $\frac{1}{3}$ ) of Lot Five (5) is bounded on the North by the North One Third ( $\frac{1}{3}$ ) and on the South by the South One Third ( $\frac{1}{3}$ ) of said Lot Five (5), and that, according to the records of the title to all of said Lot Five (5), it is impossible for the middle One Third ( $\frac{1}{3}$ ) of Lot Five (5) in Block Seventeen (17) to be located in any other way than as hereinbefore bounded and described.
