I, N. Bilderback, being first duly sworn depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with H.N. Kirby, Grantee in a certain Warranty Deed dated April 27, 1857, filed for record April 27, 1857 in the Madison County Records in Volume "F" page 436, and that I was well and personally acquainted with Horatio N. Kirby, Grantor in a certain Warranty Deed dated September 1, 1868, filed for record November 13, 1868, recorded in Madison County in Volume "W" page 327, conveying the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section Thirteen (13) Township Seventy-seven (77) Range Twenty-nine (29) and that H.N. Kirby mentioned above and Horatio N. Kirby is one and the same person. I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Jacob B. Lenocker, Grantee in a certain Warranty Deed dated January 23, 1871, filed for record March 31, 1871, Madison County records in Volume "5" page 70, and I was well and personally acquainted with J.B. Lenocker Grantor in a Quit Claim Deed dated April 8, 1880, filed April 7, 1880, recorded in Madison County Records Volume "29" page 428 conveying the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section Thirteen (13) Township Seventy-seven (77) Range Twenty-nine (29) and that Jacob B. Lenocker mentioned above and J.B. Lenocker is one and the same person. I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Ebenezer V. Hennen, Grantee in a certain Warranty Deed dated June 29, 1866, filed June 30, 1866, recorded in Madison County Records, volume "Q" page 545, conveying the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section Thirteen (13) Township Seventy-seven (77) Range Twenty-nine (29), and that I was well and personally acquainted with E.V. Hennen, Grantee in a certain Quit Claim Deed dated April 8, 1880, filed April 7, 1880, recorded in Madison County records in Volume "29" page 428, conveying the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter Section Thirteen, Township Seventy-seven, Range Twenty-nine, and that the above mentioned Ebenezer V. Hennen and E.V. Hennen refers to one and the same person, and that wherever the name of Ebenezer V. Hennen or E.V. Hennen is mentioned in any way to the title to the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section Thirteen (13) Township Seventy-seven (77) Range Twenty-nine (29), it refers to one and the same person. I make this from my personal knowledge, being a resident of Dallas and Madison Counties for more than sixty years.
