State of Iowa Dallas County SS:

I, J.T. Long of Dallas County, Iowa, being first duly sworn depose and say that I am 73 years of age and that I have resided in Dallas County more than 40 years, that I am a brother of Pierce Long, Grantee in a certain Warranty Deed, dated July 5, 1856, filed November 27, 1856 in the Madison County records in Volume "F" page 183; and that I was well and personally acquainted with Perres Long, Grantor in a certain Warranty Deed dated April 27, 1857, filed for record April 27, 1857; recorded in Madison County records in Volume "F" page 436, and that wherever the name of Pierce Long, Perres Long or Perres B. Long appears as Grantee or Grantor in the title to the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13) Township Seventy-seven (77) Range Twenty-nine (29), it refers to one and the same person. I further state that I was well and personally acquainted with Aaron B. Long, my brother, who is Grantee in a certain Warranty Deed dated February 1, 1858, filed for record February 11, 1860, recorded in Madison County records Volume "L" page 160, and that the Grantor as given in a certain Warranty Deed as John B. Long is a mistake; said Deed dated February 8, 1860, filed March 5, 1860 and recorded in Madison County records in Volume "L" page 198. That the name should be Aaron B. Long, and I do say that Aaron B. Long and John B. Long is one and the same identical person.
