I, C.B. Anthes, being first duly sworn do say that I am a resident of Lee County, Iowa, that I formerly resided in Madison County, Iowa, and was a member of the firm of Anthes Lumber Company, which firm was plaintiff in a certain action against A.L. Hoisington, defendant, and in which judgment was rendered against the said defendant on the 6th day of November, 1905, for the sum of \$112.80 and costs, and a transcript of which judgment was filed in the office of the Clerk of the District Court in and for said County and State on the 7th day of November, 1905, as is shown by Judgment Docket 12 page 50 of said County. That the judgment of the said firm of Anthes Lumber Company against the defendant A.L. Hoisington, dated November 6th, 1905 in the sum of \$112.80 and costs and of which a transcript was filed in the office of the Clerk of said Court on the 11th day of November 1905, as shown by Judgment Docket 12 page 108, is the same judgment as the one first above herein described. That the firm of Anthes Lumber Company had but one such judgment against the said A.L. Hoisington, and that said judgment was twice transcribed to the District Court as above set out.
