State of Iowa Madison County SS:

I, Martha A. Tidrick, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with A.D. Kellison and W.W. Keeling who platted Kellison and Keeling's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, and that they were the same and identical persons respectively as the Adam D. Kelison and William W. Keeling who obtained title to the land from which said Addition was platted by deed from Martin B. Ruby and wife, dated April 5th 1856 and recorded in Record "E", page 93, and that said W.W. Keeling was an unmarried man at the time said addition was platted. I further state that I was well acquainted with J.D. Holbrook who obtained title to Lots 3, 4 & 5 in Block 1 of said Kellison & Keeling's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, by deed dated April 17th 1899 and recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 9, page 465, and know that neither the said J.D. Holbrook, who was the same person as John D. Holbrook, nor his widow, Nancy E. Holbrook, ever occupied said lots as a homestead. Further deponent sayeth not.
