Letters of Administration.

Farris at the time of his death, with full power and authority to secure and dispose of said property according to law, and to collect all moneys due said deceased, and in general to do and perform all other acts and things which are or hereafter may be required of him by the law or decree or order of any Court having Jurisdiction.
