Davis, of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with William Davis and Elizabeth Davis who on December 2nd, 1858 conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 to James R. Davis and I well and personally knew that on said date the said William Davis and Elizabeth Davis were husband and wife, and I further depose and say that I am the same and identical person as James R. Davis who together with Margaret Davis conveyed the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 to William Davis on October 17th, 1866 and that on that date the said Margaret Davis was my wife, and I well and personally know that William Davis to whom I conveyed said land was the same and identical person as W. Davis who together with his wife conveyed all that part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 that lies North of Cedar Creek to John D. Brassfield on January 22nd, 1868, and I further depose and say that I well and personally knew that William Davis was an unmarried man on October 17th, 1866 when he conveyed the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 to James R. Davis, this affiant.
