State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, W.E. Ratliff, being duly sworn depose and say as follows:- That I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and have no interest in making this affidavit other than to establish the facts therein stated. That I am acquainted with the Mary Rhodes who is the daughter of A.J. Hoisington and Elizabeth Hoisington, and whose name appears as an heir at law of the said A.J. Hoisington in the registry of heirs filed in his estate in Madison County, Iowa, and whose name also appears as a daughter and heir at law of the said Elizabeth Hoisington in the registry of her heirs filed in her estate in said county. That the Mary Rhodes above named, the daughter of the said A.J. Hoisington, is not the same person as the Mary Rhodes who is named as one of the defendants in a certain action in which I was plaintiff and in which judgment was entered against the defendants on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1908, as shown by Judgment Docket 12 page 212 of the Transcripts from Justice Courts of Madison County, Iowa, and the said Mary Rhodes, daughter of A.J. Hoisington and Elizabeth Hoisington, is not the same person as the Mary E. Rhodes who is named as one of the defendants in a certain action in which E.E. McCall was plaintiff and in which the judgment is dated October 31, 1901, the amount of said judgment being \$26.05, together with \$2.60 attorney fees and \$5.50 costs. That the said Mary Rhodes or Mary E. Rhodes named as defendant in the judgments above set out is the wife of W.C. Rhodes of Winterset, Iowa, and that the said Mary Rhodes whose name appears in the ~~#####~~ prebate records of Madison County, Iowa, as a daughter and heir at law of the said A.J. Hoisington, is the wife of Samuel Rhodes and resides in the State of Nebraska.
