State of Ohio Hamilton County SS. I, Alex H. Lewis being duly sworn depose and say that I am a son of Alexander H. Lewis to whom the S¹/₂ NE¹/₄ & W¹/₂ SE¹/₄ & NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ & E¹/₂ SW¹/₄ & SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ all in 33-75-26 was patented on July 1st 1859 and that he died intestate on or about July 3rd 1870 leaving as his sole and only heirs at law Sarah M. Lewis, Widow, Eugene L. Lewis, Alex H. Lewis (your deponent) Kate L. Lewis (later married to James K. Verner) and William H. Lewis and that the estate of Alexander H. Lewis was finally settled and debts all paid previous to Apr 28th 1881. The said William H. Lewis died on or about -----, single and with out issue. Also the Alexander H. Lewis to whom the above described land was patented is the same identical person as A. H. Lewis, deceased, mentioned in certain warranty deeds dated April 28th 1881 and recorded in Book 17 page 50, of the records of Madison County, Iowa. Also the Alex H. Lewis one of the grantors in the deed recorded in Book 17 page 53 and Alexander H. Lewis one of the grantee's in the deed recorded in Book 17 page 55 are one and the same identical person and refer to myself the deponent. Also the Sarah M. Lewis and Eugene L. Lewis mentioned as grantors joining with others in a certain deed dated Dec. 18th 1884 to C. D. Bevington and recorded in Book 21 page 372 records of Madison County, Iowa, were both single and unmarried at the time of the conveyance. Further deponents sayeth not. Dated May 4th 1907.
