I, Wheatly Harper of lawful age, being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa for the past forty years; That I was well and personally acquainted with David Fisher, who at one time was the owner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ all of Section 23, Twp. 74 North of Range 28, West of the 5th P.M. Madison County, Iowa, and with his immediate family and I know of my own personal knowledge that the Thomas M. Fisher named as one of the heirs in the "Registry of Heirs" filed in the Matter of the Estate of David Fisher, Deceased, and the Thomas Fisher one of the grantors named in a certain Quit Claim Deed Dated September 9th, 1899 and recorded in Deed Record 29 at Page 620 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, which said deed conveys the above described property, is one and the same identical person, and that his true and correct name is Thomas M.
