State of Iowa Madison County SS. I, John W. Corbie, of said state and county, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say, that I was well and personally acquainted with Alexander McCullough, late of Madison county Iowa, and also with his family that the said Alexander McCullough died intestate, in the spring of the year A.D. 1882. That he left him surviving, his widow, Elizabeth McCullough, and W.A. McCullough, a son and M.A. Squires (intermarried with D.M. Squires) a daughter, Lucinda Deets, intermarried with Noah Deets, a daughter Rachel M. Corbie (my wife) a daughter, Hannah M. McCullough, a daughter intermarried with Charles McCullough (the same name but no relation) Ella Herrick, intermarried with George T. Herrick, a daughter, and Etta Scoville and Allie Scoville, granddaughters, children of his daughter Sarah Scoville, who died intestate in the winter of 1879-80, and Fred Scoville the surviving husband of the said Sarah Scoville. That no administration was had on either the estates of Alexander McCullough or Sarah Scoville, but the estates of each were long since fully settled and all debts paid and settled in full. That the said D.M. Squires and M.A. Squires were husband and wife on October 31st 1882 and that all the heirs of the said Alexander McCullough deceased have conveyed all title and interest in all the lands of which the said Alexander McCullough died seized, and that Elizabeth McCullough who joined in a deed of her interest as a daughter of the said Alexander McCullough of date October 31st, 1882, was at the time of the execution of said deed an unmarried woman, of lawful age, and all the heirs of said decedents were of legal age at the time they transferred their title to the estate of the said Alexander McCullough, and that the heirs above enumerated are the widow and all and the only heirs at law of the said Alexander McCullough.
