I, Mary E. Parker of Hartford, Warren Co. Iowa first being duly sworn do depose and say that I was the wife of Geo. T. Bever who on or about May 14th 1886 purchased of J.E. Thompson the East One-half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty-two (22) and the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-three (23) Township Seventy-five (75) North of Range Twenty-six (26) West 5 P.M. Iowa as shown by Deed record 24 on page 601 of Madison Co. Iowa. That on or about May 14th 1886 the said Geo. T. Bever and myself gave a mortgage for \$1000.00 on the above described land. That on or about Jan 15-1888 my husband the said Geo. T. Bever died intestate that is with-out making a will and left as his heirs-at-law myself-Mary E. Bever, his widow James Bever, Zona Bever, Nola Bever and Roy Bever his children and these were all and the only heirs-at-law of Geo. T. Bever deceased.

That on or about Nov 12-1888 foreclosure proceedings were started to foreclose the above mortgage and on Nov 20th 1888 original notice was served on me and the children and on Dec 18th 1888 judgment was rendered against Geo. T. Bever and Mary E. Bever as shown in Judgment docket I. Page 145 thereof.
