Madison dated October 30th, 1865, and recorded in Record "Q", page 296.

I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with A.W. McMillen who was grantee in two deeds from John McMillen and wife, Harriet M. McMillen, one dated October 28th, 1870 and recorded in Deed Record 6, page 268, the other dated November 19th, 1874 and recorded in Deed Record 9, page 513 and know of my own personal knowledge that he was the same and identical person as the A.W. McMillan who was grantee in a Quit Claim Deed from Henry Cox and wife, Sarah E. Cox, dated November 3rd, 1877 and recorded in Deed Record 15, page 141 and I further state that the said A.W. McMillan was the same and identical person as the A.W. McMillen who was grantor in a deed to C.W. Kitchel dated May 15th, 1879 and recorded in Deed Record 18, page 74.
