That the Michael E. White, Jr., and Michael E. White named in the following clause appearing in a certain warranty deed executed April 13th, 1867 and recorded on May 7th, 1867 in Deed Record "T" at Page #373 in the Madison County, Iowa, Records:—"in consideration of Five Hundred Dollars in hand paid by Michael E. White, Jr., of Madison County and State of Iowa, do hereby sell and convey unto the said Michael E. White, the following described premises" etc. refer to one and the same person, that is Michael E. White.

Also that the M.E. White named as Grantee in a warranty deed executed December 7th, 1883 and recorded December 26, 1883 in Deed Record #23 at Page 306 and re-recorded on December 24th, 1898, in Deed Record #33 at Page 417 of the Madison County, Iowa, Records is one and the same person as the Michael E. White named as Grantee in a Quit Claim Deed dated March 18th, 1895 and Recorded December 17th, 1898 in Deed Record #37 at Page 418 as well as being the same person as Michael E. White named as Grantee in a Warranty Deed executed April 13th, 1867, and Recorded May 7th, 1867 in Deed Record "T" at Page 373 of the Madison County, Iowa,

Records. And that the various writings of the same name as shown above refer to the same person as the M.E.
