State of Iowa, Madison County, SS, I, L.W. Fisher, a resident of Van Meter Iowa, of Law-
 ful age, being sworn according to law, depose and say that the Thomas Gabbert named as
 Grantee in a certain warranty deed executed on November 11th, 1881, and recorded on Dec-
 ember 17th, 1881, in Deed Record #19 at Page #545 of the Madison County, Iowa, Records, is
 one and the same person as T.G. Gabbert named as Grantor in the Warranty Deed dated Dec-
 ember 7th, 1883, and recorded on December 26th, 1883, in Deed Record #23 at Page #306 of
 the Madison County Iowa, Records.

Also that the T.G. Gabbert named as Grantor in the Warranty Deed executed on Dec-
 ember 7th, 1883 and recorded on December 24th, 1898 in Deed Record #38 at Page #417 of
 the Madison County Iowa, Records, is one and the same person as the Thomas Gabbert here-
 before mentioned in this instrument.

Also that I was appointed Administrator of the Estate of Michael White on Sept-
 ember 8th, 1909, and duly qualified as such in Dallas County, Iowa, by filing bond which
 was approved September 11, 1909, and Letters of Administration were issued By Clerk of the
 District Court of Dallas County, Iowa, on September 28th, 1909, and immediately notices of
 such appointment were posted at the following places: -One at Mayor's Office or Town
 Hall VanMeter, Iowa, One at VanMeter State Bank, VanMeter, Iowa, and One at the South Front
 Door of the Court House in Adel, Dallas County, Iowa. And further saith not.
