State of Iowa Madison County. SS. I, Lanson Howell, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with Oliver Crawford to whom Benjamin P. Allen and wife conveyed the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28-76-26 by deed dated January 18th 1855 and recorded in Record "A", page 606, and that he was the same and identical person as the Oliver Crawford who died in Madison County, Iowa, about June 11th 1874, his correct name being Oliver Crawford. I further depose and say that the said Oliver Crawford died seized of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ & E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21; and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28-76-26, and other lands, and that wherever in the settlement of the estate of the said Oliver Crawford, or in any subsequent proceedings or conveyances relating to above described lands the names S. A. Wilson or Sarah A. Wilson occur, they refer to the same person; that Maria T. Stiles is the same person as Maria F. Stiles; that W. W. Crawford is the same person as William W. Crawford; and that C. S. Crawford is the same person as Charles S. Crawford, or Chas. S. Crawford, or Charley S. Crawford; each of said persons being a child and heir at law of the said Oliver Crawford.

I further depose and say that Cassius H. Small who was one of the mortgagees in a certain mortgage executed by Douglas Debord and wife, covering the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 28-76-26, and recorded in Mortgage Record 30. page 299, died prior to the year 1897, leaving as his sole heirs his widow, Mrs. Ruby Small, and his brother Frank L. Small and that said Mrs. Ruby Small and Frank L. Small released said mortgage on the margin thereof April 14th 1897. All the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
