State of Iowa, Madison County: SS. I, J.W. Smith, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:—That I am the same identical person as the J.W. Smith named as grantee in a certain deed from Harry C. Clearwater and wife Nora, dated December 6th, 1901, recorded in Deed Record No. 14, at Page 117, of the records of the County Recorder's Office of Madison County, Iowa, conveying Lot Three (3) in Block Sixteen (16) of West Addition to Winterset, Iowa and that I am the present owner of said real estate: That I never lived in Monroe Township, Madison County, Iowa in my life nor in Earlham, Iowa and never had any personal property located in either of said places subject to taxation: that the personal taxes levied against J.W. Smith in Earlham, Iowa for 1894, 1895, 1900, 1902 and 1908 were levied and assessed against some other J.W. Smith than this affiant: that my first name is James and the taxes levied against John W. Smith in Monroe Township in said county in 1911 were not against me, that the personal tax of 50¢ levied against J.W. Smith in Winterset, Iowa for 1900 and remaining unpaid were levied against and due from one John W. Smith who resided in Winterset at that time: that none of the taxes above described are, or ever were, a lien upon the property herein described. Further deponent sayeth not.
