I, Allen Moorman of lawful age on oath depose and say, that I was by the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, appointed Administrator with Will annexed, of the estate of Daniel Moorman deceased, and that I continued to act as such Administrator until October 3rd 1913, at which time I was discharged by said Court. That in my final report, filed September 17th 1913, I stated that certain real estate in Earlham Iowa, described as Block Eight (8) of Wilson's Addition to said town, was sold for \$2400.00 \$500.00 being paid down and the balance to be paid October 1st 1913. That said sale was not made by me as Administrator, nor did I file any petition or obtain any order of Court, authorizing me to make said sale, that the sale was made by the Widow and all of the heirs of Daniel Moorman, deceased, and that a deed was executed by them, together with their husbands and wives, conveying said property to George E. Bricker, that none of the proceeds of said sale passed through my hands as Administrator, as the same was turned over to the widow by myself, acting as Agent for all of the heirs of the said Daniel Moorman, deceased.

The statement made in my final report, as showing the sale of said property was a mistake, so far as I was concerned as Administrator, as I did make the sale, acting as Agent for the widow and heirs as aforesaid, and further affiant saith not.
