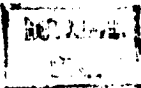

State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, David S. DeWitt, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:—That I am the same identical person as the David S. DeWitt named as grantee in a certain deed from J. C. Kennedy, dated August 8th, 1900, recorded in Deed Record No. 40, at Page 555 of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying 65 acres of W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 being all of said W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  lying North of Cedar Creek, and the same identical person as the D. S. DeWitt who deeded a strip of land across said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 to the Des Moines Southern Railway Company, by warranty deed, dated October 30th, 1902, and recorded in Deed Record NO 44, at Page 26 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, and know of my own knowledge that ~~as~~ said railroad was then staked out and located across said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section the same did not touch the North West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South East Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section 23, but that said railroad was located and staked out across said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 South of the South line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27. That I have no interest to serve in making this affidavit except to establish the facts as herein set out. Further deponent sayeth not.
