

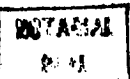

I, Joseph C. Kennedy, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath depose and say:- That I am the same identical person as the Joseph C. Kennedy, named in the will of James Kennedy, my father, which was probated in the District Court of Madison County Iowa on the 28th day of September, 1892, and who is named as one of the heirs at law of said James Kennedy in the registry of heirs filed in said estate in said court as Joseph C. Kennedy, and the same identical person as the J. C. Kennedy named as grantor in a deed to David S. DeWitt, dated August 8th, 1900, recorded in Deed Record 41 at Page 555 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa. That the James Kennedy named in said will and who executed the same was my father and the same identical person as the James Kennedy to whom William Graham conveyed so much of the W $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  23-76-27 as lies North of Cedar Creek, by deed dated April 26th, 1873 and recorded in Deed Record 7, at Page 417 of the deed records of Madison County, Iowa. That all the above facts are known to me of my personal knowledge and that I have no interest in making this affidavit except to establish the above facts.
