State of Iowa Madison County, SS. I, Mark D.Hill, being first duly affirmed depose and say that on October 14, 1913 I made a certain Affidavit filed October 21, 1913, recorded in Madison County Misc.records 18, page 185. In this Affidavit I gave the list of heirs of Seth Wilson in a certain Quit Claim Deed dated October 1, 1891, record in Madison County records 29, page 445. I further state this was an error on the part of the party drawing the Affidavit and it should have referred to the Deed dated December 18, 1889, recorded in Madison County Deed record 28, page 584. The facts in the case are that at the time of the first above mentioned Deed Eliza A.Griffin was not living and at the time of the last above mentioned Deed she was living, as I have state more fully in a joint Affidavit with Joseph Ledlie. I further state the children and grand children of Eliza A.Griffin at the time of the recording of a certain Deed recorded in Madison County record 29, page 445, were as follows: The children of Eliza A.Griffin being Sarah E.Constable, Homer V.Griffin, Ella J.Diggs, Edgar D.Griffin, Anna G.Williams, Oliver P.Griffin, Benjamin S.Griffin. I further state M.W.Griffin, a son of Eliza A.Griffin, was not living at thistime and was survived by his widow Pernelia H.Griffin and his children Grace Griffin and Will Griffin.
