Hill and Joseph Ledlie, being first duly affirmed and depose and say that we were personally acquainted with Seth Wilson and all his heirs, and that on December 18 1889, the date of a certain Deed recorded in Madison County Record 28, page 584, conveying the West Ten (10) acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6) Township Seventy-seven (77) Range Twenty-eight (28) Eliza A. Griffin, a daughter of Seth Wilson was living and signed the above described Deed, and we further state that on October 1, 1891, the date of recording a certain Deed recorded in Madison County Deed record 29, page 445, conveying the East Thirty (30) acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South<sup>east</sup> Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Six (6) Township Seventy seven (77) Range Twenty-eight (28) the said Eliza A. Griffin was deceased, thence her children and heirs signed said Deed as their Mother Eliza A. Griffin was not living.
