State of Iowa Dallas County, SS. I, B.B. Lienemann, a resident of said County and State on my oath depose and say that I am a son of Bractor P. Lienemann, who died testate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about November 21st, 1900, and whose last will and testament was admitted to probate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about February 6th, 1901, that the Emma Demot and Lena Sigel, named in said last will and testament are respectively the same and identical persons as Emma Demuth and Lena Crocker, who are grantors in a certain quit claim deed dated December 28th, 1900, to Johanna Lienemann, conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 6-77-27 (and other land).

I further state that I am the same person as Brack B. Lienemann, who is named as one of the grantors in a certain warranty deed to F.E. Wight, dated July 18th, 1908, conveying the SW frac. $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 6-77-27, and that I am also the same person as Brack B. Leanemann, named as grantee in a deed from Johanna Lienemann, dated October 2nd, 1906, conveying the real estate last above described, my name in the said last mentioned deed being misspelled by mistake.

I further state that the Brachter P. Lienemann, who is one of the grantors in a deed to Brack B. Lienemann dated February 26th, 1896, conveying the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 6-77-27, was my father, and that he is the same and identical person as Brachter Lienmann grantee in a deed dated May 13th, 1881, from Jacob Payton and wife, conveying the land above described.
