State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, P.C. Herren, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I have resided in the vicinity of Madisburg, Iowa since long prior to the laying out and platting of said town in the year 1873, and have been familiar with the properties herein named. That while in platting said town the blocks were not numbered, the lots being numbered consecutively from #1 to #30, as is shown by the record of said plat recorded in Deed Record 10, page 67, subsequently certain blocks were sometimes designated by number, the block lying south of South Street and east of East Street being frequently designated as block 4, and the Lots 25 to 29 inclusive in block 4 referred to in deed recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 1, page 622, and in Town Lot Mortgage Record 2, page 78, and in Deed Record 12, page 501, and in foreclosure proceedings docketed in Appearance Docket 6, page 108 of the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa,

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and in Sheriff's Deed Record "A", page 215, each and all refer to Lots 25 to 29 inclusive of the Original Town of Macksburg, Iowa, all the above records being of Madison County, Iowa.
