White, named as grantee in a certain deed from J. H. Creger and wife dated March 2nd, 1907, recorded in Deed Record 44 at Page 370 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  22-74-26 and know that he is the same identical person as the David A. White named as grantor in a certain deed conveying the same property to Samuel Maxwell, dated March 5th, 1910 and recorded in Deed Record 52 at Page 63 of said Madison County, Iowa, records.
