State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, Joshua Aikin, being first duly sworn on my oath, depose and say that I am a brother of J.B. Aikin to whom Stewart S. Probst and wife conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29-75-29 by deed dated March 22nd 1875 and recorded in Deed Recorded 11, page 74, and know that the name "Adkin" as shown on the record of said conveyance was an error either in drawing said conveyance or of the recorder in recording the same, his correct name being "J.B. Aikin".

I further state that the Stewart S. Probst who executed the conveyance above referred to was the same and identical person as the Stewart S. Probst who obtained title to said land from Thomas A. Stone and wife by deed dated March 29th 1867 and recorded in Record "T", page 311.

I further state that the J.B. Aikin or "Adkin" named as grantee in the conveyance first above referred to was the same and identical person as the J.B. Aikin who subsequently conveyed said land to Anna E. Aikin by deed dated September 9th 1879, and recorded in Deed Record 15, page 403 and that on the date of said conveyance, the said Anna E. Aikin was the wife of the said J.B. Aikin. All the above records being of Madison County, Iowa.
