State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, William Fenimore being duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I have lived in the immediate vicinity of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 25-75-27, west 5th P.M. Madison County, Iowa, for more than 50 years and that I have known all the parties who have owned or resided upon the aforesaid land in that time. And I well and personally know that Edward M. Greenway, Jr. nor Grace A. Greenway, never at any time occupied the above described premises prior to September 1st 1854 or since that time and that neither one of the aforesaid parties lived upon the said land or used the same as a homestead. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Norvell S. Allcock to whom Edward M. Greenway Jr. conveyed the aforesaid land as shown by deed record A page 627 of the records of Madison county, Iowa, and know that he is the same and identical person as N.S. Allcock who with his wife, Lucy H. Allcock conveyed by warranty deed, the aforesaid land to William C. Allcock, said deed being dated September, 28, 1867 and recorded in deed record T page 561 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that the said William C. Allcock to whom said land was conveyed is the same and identical person as W.C. Allcock who with his wife, Rebecca A. Allcock conveyed by warranty deed the above described land to N.S. Allcock as shown by deed record 6 at page 427 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, I further depose and say that William B. Allen to whom said land was conveyed by N.S. Allcock by warranty deed as shown by deed record 41 at page 12 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, is the same and identical person as W.B. Allen who with his wife Hannah M. Allen conveyed the aforesaid land to J.W. Ray by warranty deed dated February 24th 1898 as shown by deed record 38 at page 214 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that the said Hannah M. Allen was the wife of W.B. Allen at that time, and that Francis E. Allen and Frances B. Allen were one and the same person and the former wife of William B. Allen, she having died prior to February 24th 1898, and that the said W.B. Allen nor William B. Allen had afterwards married Hannah M. Allen, who was his wife on February 24th 1898, when the aforesaid deed was executed to J.W. Ray. I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Norvel S. Allcock who entered the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 25-75-27, from the United States Government under Certificate No. 20126 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 25-75-27 with land warrant No. 38265 and know that the said Norvel S. Allcock is the same identical person as N.S. Allcock who with his wife Lucy H. Allcock executed a warranty deed to William B. Allen, being dated March 5th 1855 and recorded in deed record K at page 251 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that the said Norvel S. Allcock, Norvell S. Allcock and N.S. Allcock are one and the same identical person. And that the said W.B. Allen, William B. Allen and Wm B. Allen are one and the same person.

The foregoing statements are made from my personal knowledge and I have no personal interest in making this affidavit, and further deponent saith not. William Fenimore
