ARTICLE I.

We, the undersigned, members and officers of the Evening Star Lodge No. 43 A.F. and A.M., for ourselves and for the said Lodge and for the presents and future members thereof, do hereby reorganize and re-incorporate for the benefit of both the present and future members of said Lodge with all the powers and privileges allowed by the laws of the State of Iowa under Chapter 2 of Title 9 of the Code of Iowa.

ARTICLE II.

This corporation shall be known by the name of "Evening Star Lodge No. 43 A.F. and A.M."

ARTICLE III.

The object of this corporation shall be to acquire and hold such property as may be necessary and convenient for the fraternal society known as the Masonic Lodge at Winterset, Iowa, and which has heretofore existed under the name of Evening Star Lodge No. 43 A.F. and A.M. And this corporation may purchase and acquire property and build or own and hold a building to be occupied for the purpose of said Masonic Lodge; and also to acquire and own such regalia, furniture and "properties" as it may need. And to that end this corporation shall be vested with all the property and rights of the corporation known as Evening Star Lodge No. 43 A.F. and A.M., whose articles of incorporation were filed and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on the 16th day of January A.D. 1875, in Book No. 1 page 461 of the Miscellaneous records of said office.

ARTICLE IV.

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed under the directions of Evening Star Lodge No. 43 A.F. and A.M. by a Board of Trustees, the present members of which Board are Charles McMillan, W.J. Cornell and L. Lowe, who shall hold their office for the full term for which they were heretofore elected by said Lodge, and who shall hold their office until their successors are duly elected in the manner and form and at the time as provided by said Evening Star Lodge No. 43 A.F. and A.M..

Article V.

The indebtedness of this corporation shall not exceed the sum of Eighty-five Hundred Dollars (\$8500.00).
